Parents as Teachers is the world's largest evidence based home visiting program.

What do we do?

Our trained parent educators visit their families twice a month to bring information on child development and parenting, interactive activities, and a free book at each visit!

Eligibility:

There are no income guidelines, this is free for any resident of Brooke, Hancock, or Marshall County with a child prenatally up until Kindergarten. Foster, kinship, grandfamily, natural family – all are welcome!



How does it work?

Families or agencies can send a referral form via Facebook, email, or hand it in to one of our staff, who will contact the family within 48 hours to discuss the program and schedule an enrollment visit or, when necessary, add them to our waitlist.

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Once an enrollment visit is scheduled, the assigned educator will come to the home to complete the enrollment. From there, we work with families during our twice monthly visits to encourage parent-child interaction, build on strengths, track milestones, and connect the family to various resources to help everyone meet their goals!

Ways We Help:

Milestones and Screenings

Educators and parents work together to track developmental milestones, and to complete screenings that ensure children are developmentally on track, and refer for appropriate interventions.

Expert Staff

We have a trained Doula, Certified Breastfeeding Specialist, Carseat Technician, Infant Massage, and autism specialist – all ready to assist families how and when they want! We are also trained in trauma informed care, intimate partner violence, substance use disorder, and much more.

Resource Connections

As a program under the Family Resource Network, we have direct access to the food, baby, and hygiene pantries. We are knowledgeable on several organizations in the community that help families and love making those connections.

Community

We plan events and host "group connections" to encourage family-to-family engagement, promote recreation, and foster socialization.
