Parents as Teachers (PAT) is a **FREE** In-Home Family Education program. The Parents as Teachers program provides parent education and family support to parents throughout pregnancy until their child enters kindergarten.

Parents are supported by certified parent educators through personal in-home visits, group meetings, and community resource and referrals.



★ *Personal Visits are the heart of PAT. A certified parent educator comes to the comfort of your own home to help you understand what to expect during your pregnancy, delivery and as your child grows and develops.*



★ *Group Meetings allow you to meet with other parents to gain new insight, share experiences, and discuss pregnancy and parenting topics.*



★ *PAT can link you with community resources and make referrals to help support you and your family that go beyond the scope of PAT.*
