Healthy relationships are the foundation of a child's physical and emotional development. They implement this knowledge into all training and technical assistance provided. The development of a close stable relationship influences the child's development of language, social/emotional skills, and concept of self. The Infant – Toddler Specialist offers WVIT I and WVIT II in the Wheeling and Morgantown CCRC offices throughout the program year.</p>	<p><u>Early Childhood Specialist's</u> The Early Childhood Specialists Child Care Professionals can request technical assistance from your ECS to address challenges and improve the quality of the program. Technical Assistance can include: Room Arrangement Routine & Activity Positive Interactions & Learning Centers.</p>
<p><u>TRAILS</u> <i>Traveling Resource and Information System</i> TRAILS is a free lending library system that delivers various childcare resources to registered or licensed West Virginia providers who accept subsidy certificates, including family child care homes, facilities and child care centers. TRAILS offers Technical Assistance to all providers, follow up consultations following a visit or referral from other professional development team members along with providing information for providers to seek information on addition services available in your local community.</p>	 <p>Visit us at www.crcwv.org</p>	<p><u>Quality Improvement Specialist</u> The Quality Improvement Specialist works closely with the State Coordinator to gain expertise on licensing, registration, and tiered reimbursement requirements. The QIS performs marketing and outreach to child care providers and consumers on quality improvement. In addition telephone, and on-site consultation to directors of child care centers, family child care facilities and family child care homes and community and education on tiered reimbursement and quality improvement is also provided.</p>
